EVENT DETAILS			
On February 28, 2015, PWBC was initially scheduled to import 250 MW of energy for the HE 19 and HE 20 settlement periods. At approximately 17:41 MST the AESO curtailed the PWBC import schedule for HE 19 from 250 MW to 208 MW. At 17:43 MST an available capability (AC) restatement was submitted having the effect of restating AC for HE 19 from 250 MW to 208 MW however, the 17:43 restatement also restated AC for HE 20 from 250 MW to 208 MW without an acceptable operational reason (AOR). The error was corrected at 19:06 MST. ISO rule 203.6 indicates that a pool participant must submit an energy restatement in accordance with subsection 3.5.3.2 of the ISO rules (superseded by ISO rule 203.3) if there is any change in the available capability of the asset. ISO rule 203.3 requires that a pool participant must only submit an available capability restatement if such a revision is a result of an acceptable operational reason.			
FINDINGS			
Based upon the information obtained by the MSA, the MSA is satisfied that the event was a contravention of ISO Rule 203.6.			
MATERIAL FACTS			
The material facts relied upon by the MSA include the following: 1. AESO available capability and e-tag data for PWBC for February 28, 2015. 2. Self-report from Powerex Corp. to the MSA dated March 11, 2015.
