However, the sum of the e-tag volumes for those hours was 0 MW. ISO rule 203.6 indicates that a pool participant must submit e-tags for an energy interchange transaction such that the sum of the e-tag volumes agrees with the available capability (AC) of the asset as stated two hours prior to the start of the settlement interval. **FINDINGS** Based upon the information obtained by the MSA, the MSA is satisfied that the event was a contravention of ISO Rule 203.6. MATERIAL FACTS The material facts relied upon by the MSA include the following: AESO e-tag, and available capability data for TEBC for October 9, 2015.
