At 8:21 ENOL received an ancillary services directive to reduce load by 8 MW. Between 8:21 and 8:31, ENOL reduced load by approximately 3 MW; 5 MW less than the directed amount. ISO rule section 205.6 indicates that a pool participant must ensure that after receiving a directive to provide supplemental reserve, the asset is providing the quantity of real power equal to the instantaneous amount of real power of the asset at the time of the directive plus the amount of real power set out in the directive, no later than ten minutes after receiving the directive. **FINDINGS** Based upon the information obtained by the MSA, the MSA is satisfied that the event was a contravention of ISO Rule 205.6. **MATERIAL FACTS** The material facts relied upon by the MSA include the following: 1. AESO generation and ancillary service directive data for ENOL for May 20, 2016. AESO information request issued to EnerNOC Ltd. dated August 29, 2016. EnerNOC Ltd. response to the AESO information request dated September 13, 2016.
