The declared available capability (AC) for CNR5 for the following settlement interval (HE 1 on August 16th) was 0 MW. At approximately 23:44 on August 15th, CNR5 received an advanced dispatch to 0 MW for HE 1 on August 16th. At approximately 23:46 on August 15th, the AC of CNR5 for HE 1 on August 16th was restated from 0 MW to 15 MW. ISO rule section 203.3 indicates that if there is a change in AC of the source asset, the pool participant must restate AC as soon as reasonably practicable. **FINDINGS** Based upon the information obtained by the MSA, the MSA is satisfied that the event was a contravention of ISO Rule 203.3. **MATERIAL FACTS** The material facts relied upon by the MSA include the following: 1. AESO generation, dispatch, and available capability data for CNR5 for August 15 and 16, 2016. AESO information request issued to Canadian Natural Resources Ltd. dated October 31, 2016. Canadian Natural Resources Ltd.'s response to the AESO information request dated November 22, 2016. Submission from Canadian Natural Resources Ltd. to the MSA dated November 22, 2016.
