MSA FINDINGS

From July 19, 2022 to October 31, 2022, Conrad Solar Inc. engaged in commissioning activities in relation to the CRD2 asset. On several days in the period from July 21, 2022 to October 31, 2022, Conrad Solar Inc. did not, on the day of and not less than one hour prior to the scheduled time of commissioning or testing, phone the ISO and obtain verbal authorization from the ISO to proceed.

Section 505.3 of the ISO rules states, in part:

(2) Each of the legal owner of a generating unit and the legal owner of an aggregated generating facility must, on the day of and not less than one (1) hour prior to the scheduled time of commissioning or testing, phone the ISO and obtain verbal authorization from the ISO to proceed.

(3) After receiving authorization to proceed with its commissioning or testing activities, the legal owner of a generating unit and the legal owner of an aggregated generating facility may commence the commissioning or testing activities

The MSA is satisfied that the conduct was a contravention of section 505.3 of the ISO rules.

NOTICE

The Market Surveillance Administrator (MSA) is granted the power and authority under s. 52 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act* to issue a Notice of Specified Penalty where the MSA is satisfied that a person has contravened an ISO rule. Specified penalties are set out in AUC Rule 019.

In accordance with the relevant enactments and rules, a dispute regarding the issuance of a Notice of Specified Penalty or failure to pay the specified penalty in accordance with this notice will result in a hearing or other proceeding before the AUC.

In accordance with s. 5.1 of AUC Rule 019 this Notice of Specified Penalty will be made public no earlier than receipt of confirmation of payment from the Commission and no later than 45 days after issuance. The MSA will, if applicable, also post on its website the link to any decision of the AUC respecting the specified penalty.
